UK's leading tech-enabled mobile security provider, serving 6,000+ enterprise clients including banks, government, and 93% of the UK's top 30 facilities management companies. Frontend team of six across four product squads, each owning a different product area; one engineer per squad, giving high individual ownership.

Built and shipped a real-time Command dashboard from scratch, giving enterprise clients (EY, Mitie) live visibility of ~1,000 daily security incidents - previously surfaced only via ad-hoc searches and phone calls. Owned frontend delivery end-to-end: scoped the flow, broke work into tickets, aligned payload contracts and endpoint design with backend, and shipped behind a feature flag with a phased rollout (EY validation first, then Mitie). First WebSocket implementation on the team, chose the library, designed the reconnection and auth approach, handled pagination for high-volume incident streams, and covered the feature with Playwright E2E and unit tests.

Authored the team's WebSocket ADRs and supporting research document as the project developed, establishing a reference for future real-time work.

Leading frontend delivery of a new On-Site Assessment page (4-week timeline) supporting client-side PDF generation (jsPDF) and multi-state report flows (in-progress, not assessed, complete) including reassessment paths. Working ahead of backend by agreeing on shared types and API contracts upfront to avoid blockers, and coordinating with a parallel mobile app build where assessments are captured.

Rewriting the occurrence creation flow to consolidate a fragmented process into a single full-view experience.

Migrated significant portions of the codebase from Redux Toolkit to TanStack Query, reducing boilerplate and improving cache handling for server state.

Pushed for and established team engineering practices: documented architectural decisions and recurring mistakes for shared reference, and tightened the code review process to require explicit reviewer assignment and addressed Copilot feedback before merge.

Fixed a broken CI workflow that was incorrectly attempting to auto-assign chatbot agents to E2E test failure issues, restoring reliable failure triage.

Global ticket distribution platform (part of AIM-listed Accesso Technology Group, serving 1,200+ venues worldwide), connecting ticketing systems to 60+ third-party distributors including Groupon, Ticketmaster, and LoveTheatre. The platform handled millions of transactions and traffic at similar scale, reaching over 1 billion potential customers via partner networks. Worked across a legacy whitelabel stack (Django, AngularJS, React, jQuery, AMP) serving 100+ partner tenants, and on a ground-up Angular 16 rebuild.

Shipped new-site rebuild to production across home and event pages, rolled out gradually to B2B clients worldwide. Worked in a team of 3 mid-level engineers over 6+ months rebuilding a fragmented stack (Django + AngularJS + React) into a unified Angular 16 application. Owned the wizard component, an adaptive multi-flow booking experience integrated into the event page, replacing the standalone booking page entirely, covering calendar, quantity picker, time picker, seat map, and checkout summary. Improved page load speed over the legacy site.

Led user-facing performance and redesign work on legacy partner sites, improving page load speed, SEO visibility on Google, and visual design.

Built and shipped a Zendesk-integrated feedback widget end-to-end, deployed across the booking app to capture targeted user feedback in response to a measured drop in conversion (particularly on iPhone). Owned design through delivery including widget placement and integration.

Owned Google Tag Manager implementation including a reusable gtm_config component and authored the internal wiki documentation for ops.

Diagnosed and resolved a site-wide outage caused by an invalid JSON change pushed via a non-engineering control panel, after Sentry failed to surface the root cause. Isolated the issue by systematically ruling out deployments and code changes, then tracing it to a config change made by another department, in the end restoring service and prompting a review of the control panel's input validation.

Ran technical interviews for 2 mid-to-senior frontend hires, including live coding and culture-fit stages; supported candidates through problem-solving with targeted hints.

Supported a new Product Manager ad-hoc on epic breakdown, estimation, and refining agile ceremonies that worked for the team.

Ran WILD Fridays, a biweekly internal engineering knowledge-share (wisdom, impact, learning, development) with ~10 engineers attending. Covered topics ranging from micro-frontends to intelligence analysis, spaced repetition, best engineering practices; presented some topics myself.
